Benefits for training centers

- We take care of your international students: having the best health insurance is essential to cover any medical needs they may have during their period of training in a host country.

Other benefits included in your Cigna Insurance Plan

Cigna Telemedicine 24 hours

Our team of doctors is at your disposal to answer your questions at any time, 365 days a year. This service is especially useful for obtaining advice in situations, urgent or not, in which you need support, advice and/or coordination from a doctor, always in a clear and friendly language.

Emergencies when travelling abroad

Wherever you are⁴, in the event of an emergency, you will receive medical assistance on your travels thanks to one of the highest coverages on the market. This cover includes urgent medical expenses up to a maximum of €20,000 per claim and insured, urgent dental expenses up to €300 (per claim and insured), medical transfer or repatriation of mortal remains, return expenses for companions and dispatch of medicines in the event of an emergency, among others.

Psychological counseling

This service allows you to make psychological consultations (anxiety, relationships, depression, stress, etc.) by telephone and through our website www.cigna.es. Our team of psychologists will attend to you in a personalised way and with absolute confidentiality, as well as following up on each consultation.

Second Medical Opinion

In case of serious illness, a second diagnosis and knowledge of the most advanced therapeutic alternatives is highly desirable. Specialists of recognised international prestige will make a personalised study of your case, without the need to travel.

Nutritional advisor by phone

Our nutrition specialists work to help you maintain a proper dietary balance, advising you to understand what types of foods are healthiest and most recommended.

24-hour pregnancy helpline

Members who are pregnant have at their disposal a permanent 24-hour helpline, 365 days a year, where they can obtain information and advice on pregnancy or the postpartum period.

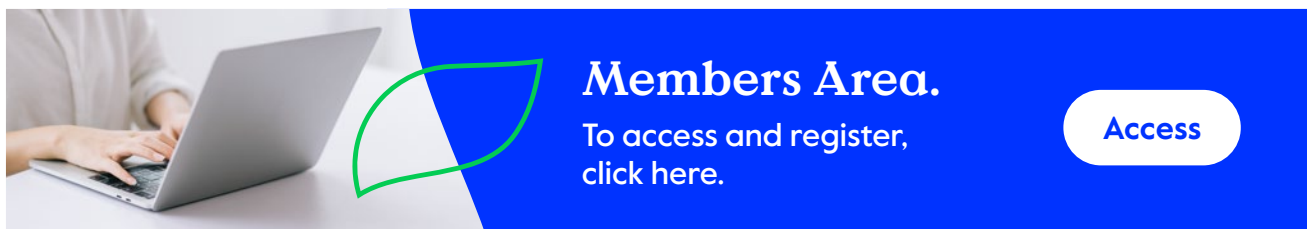

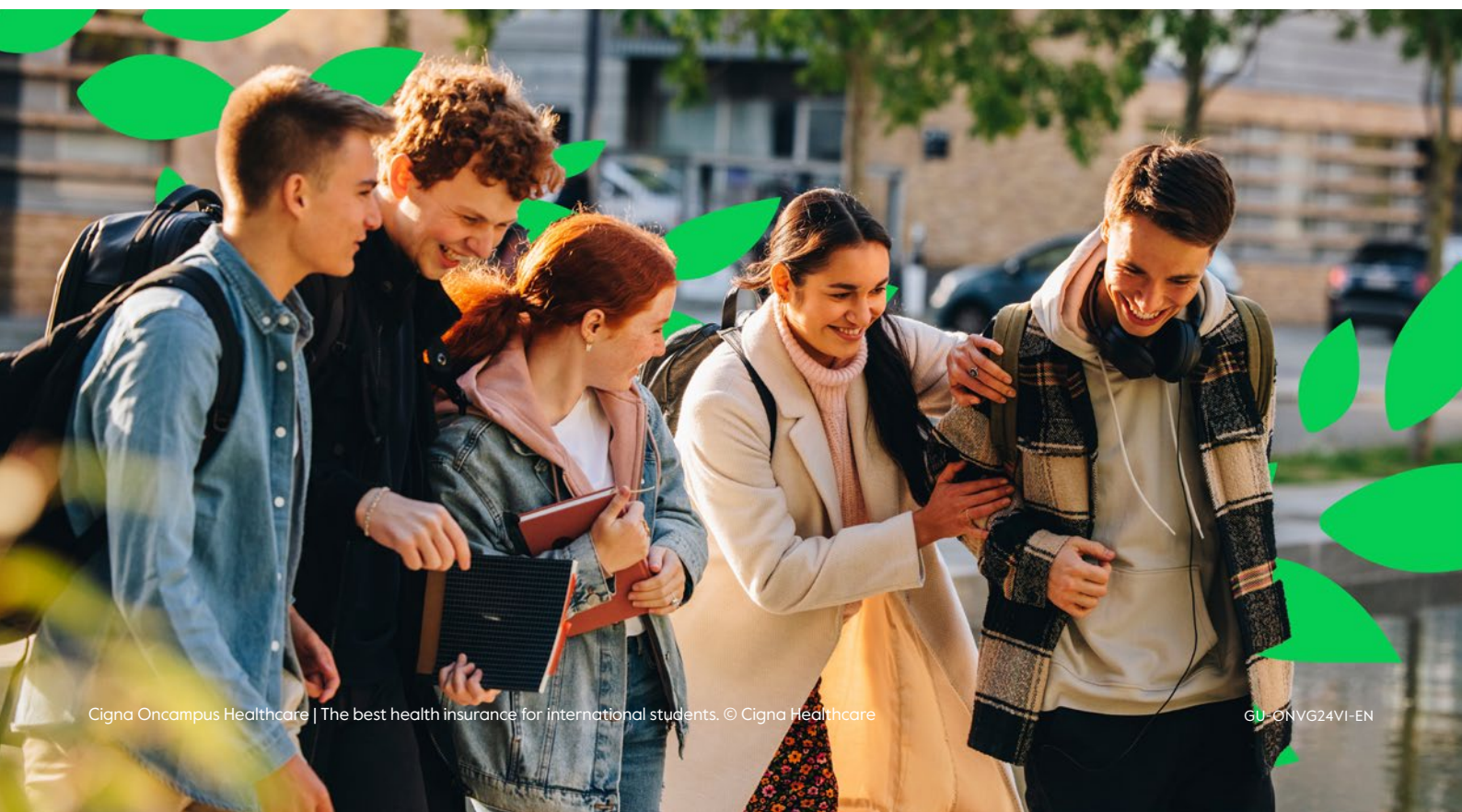
